When the Maccabees miraculously became victorious over the Greeks, they returned to the Temple to rekindle the menorah. They searched and found only one jug of pure oil, enough to light the menorah for a single day.

A miracle occurred, and the menorah remained lit with this oil for eight days, after which they could prepare more oil to keep the menorah burning beyond the eight days.

For this reason, the Chanukah menorah has eight candles as opposed to the seven that were prescribed for the Temple.



Create your miracle story


Choose five everyday things from around your house, such as a small toy, a photo, something from your school bag. Put all your found treasures into a bag. This is your treasure bag.
